

2. Meetings


2.1 SDH2018 (Moscow, June 7-9, 2018)

The International Symposium on Spatial Data Handling is a biennial international research forum initiated and organized by Commission 16.11. **The 18th International Symposium on Spatial Data Handling** (SDH 2018) was held in Russian State Library on June 7-9, 2018, right after the IGU Thematic Conference. It was hosted by Institute of Geography of the Russian Academy of Sciences and Russian State Library. Olga Solominia, the director of Institute of Geography of RAS, addressed on the opening ceremony. Professor Andrej Medvedeff from our commission chaired the symposium. The theme of the symposium is "Technological challenges and informational challenges" and the topics include: spatial analysis, modeling and data mining; big data and sensor networks; geospatial data quality and data integration; spatial data infrastructures and interoperability; open source and open data; thematic cartography and multivariate data mapping; remotely-sensed data for mapping.
