2. Meetings


2.1 SDH&GI2021 (Sakarya, August 13-14)

The International Symposium on Spatial Data Handling (SDH) is the premier long-running forum in geographical information science. The 19th SDH was planned in 2020 but was postponed to 2021 because of COVID-19. This year, we changed the title of the symposium to "International Symposium on Spatial Data Handling and Geographic Intelligence (SDH&GI)" to keep pace with the development in GIScience field.

Due to the ongoing epidemic conditions, the SDH&GI 2021 had been organized the online at Sakarya University between 13-14 August 2021. It was co-organized by the Commission on Geographic Information Science and the Commission on Modelling Geographical Systems (C20.34).

Symposium was aimed to bring together all Geographical Information Systems users and researchers to share their experiences in GIS research. The theme that our meeting will focus on this year will be under the heading of "Smart Cities and the World System". In the symposium program there were 5 keynote Speeches, 9 Sessions and 43 oral presentations.

Sessions titled: Historical GIS, Climate Change, Urban Growth, Geographical Knowledge Graph and GeoAl, Remote sensing and GIS Applications in Human Science, Fluvial Geomorphology and Natural Risks, Ecosystems, Tourism and Statistic and GIS.

The symposium successfully finished after oral presentations and Prof. Dr. Fenzhen Su made the closing speech by thanking everyone.


2.2 International conference of GIScience (Mashhad, December 12)

2.3 International "Night of Geography"



During the one-hour activity, Talks and presentations introducing FUM Geography department, GeoNight and Department of Botany and Biodiversity Research, University of Vienna were given.
